1. Water must be available on site for maintenance with the understanding that the organization receiving the donation is responsible for watering, etc.
2. The donation could include additives for the soil and a soil test if the MG's deem it necessary.
3. A plaque or other recognition will be installed. This marker provided by the MG's will identify the type of tree or shrub planted; that it was donated by the Lexington Master Gardeners and the date planted.
